ICAA withdraws from CPA merger discussions

You may have heard that the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Alberta (ICAA) announced it was withdrawing from unification discussions with the CMA and CGA Alberta organizations and from national unification talks effective immediately.

This was a surprising development as discussions had progressed well to this point and we continue to believe a merger would be a very positive development for the members of all three accounting bodies. Both CGA and CMA Alberta are disappointed we were not able to get to the stage where we could share our vision with all members.

The CPA unification discussions are continuing across the country. The next steps for CMA and CGA Alberta will be discussed with our respective boards. Unification of the profession remains our goal. More information will be shared with you in the coming weeks.
